

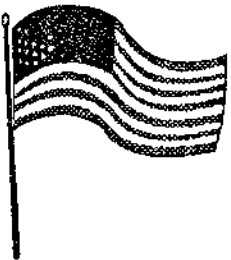

***Drive Through the Village:** Assemble in the parking lot of Indian Springs Baptist Church. Drive along Highway 119 and turn right onto Valley View Road. Proceed to Indian Crest Drive and turn left; go to Arrow Head Lane and turn left. At Highway 119 turn right and proceed to Indian Springs School on the left.

(This is not a parade; stop at all traffic signals and signs as usual. Please do not interfere with ordinary traffic--some people have other agendas we must respect. It will be fun to drive the designated route to show our town spirit and kick off our first July 4 celebration. Relax, have fun, but be considerate of others.)

***Villagers' Parade:** After the drive through the village, the vehicles will be joined at the entrance to the school grounds for a parade to the picnic site. Horses, Cyclists, Villagers with Patriotic Pets (on leashes), Roller Bladers, and others may join the Parade at this point.

Bring Your Cameras--There will be a photo contest later for the best pictures of the day's events.

Editor's Notes:

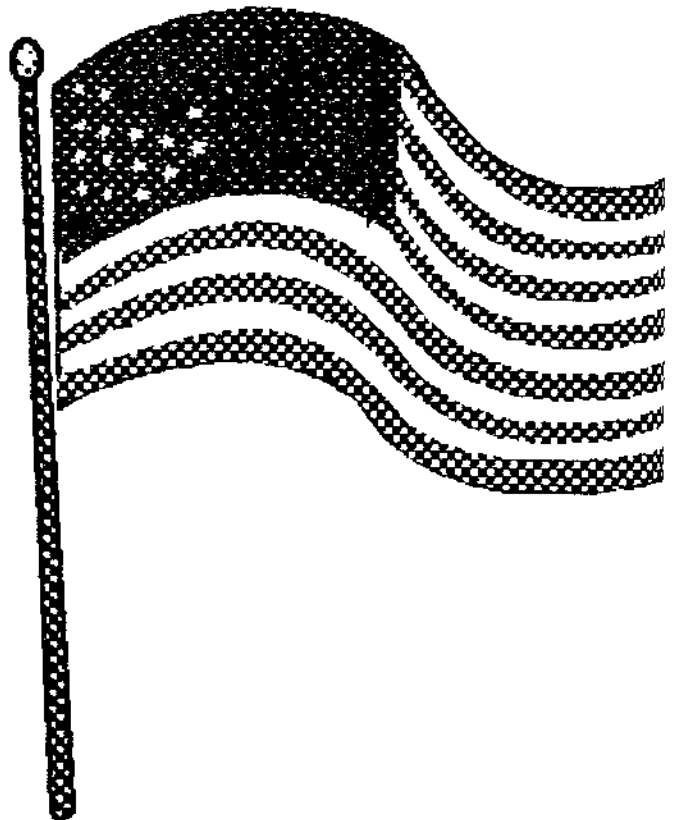

FOURTH OF JULY FUN RUN

Two Mile Walk or Jog

This is a great way to start the day--exercise with the whole village!

7:30 a.m. Registration (or pre register with form below)

8:00 a.m. Start

Entry Fee of \$10 includes an ISV T-shirt

Park to register (avoiding blocking driveways) at the circle at the dead end of Brook Green Lane or on the left side of Brook Green Lane. (South side of Alabama Highway 119 off Mountain Vista Road)

The FUN RUN route will start at the intersection of Mountain Vista and Highway 119 and proceed on Mountain Vista, turning left on Brook Green Lane, right on Indian Trail, right on Signal Trail across Bishop Creek and up the hill to the turnaround. The second leg retraces the first, but ends at the registration circle instead of the Highway 119 intersection.

Volunteers will provide safety supervision and water along the route.

Paramedics will be available, if needed, from the North Shelby County Fire District.

If possible, please register in advance in order that you may be notified of any changes in scheduling. Also T-shirts are being printed in a very limited edition.
